<u>The Building (Scotland) Act 2003</u> <u>Dangerous Building Ref. No. DB/17/05</u> <u>Dangerous Canopy over Petrol Filling Station, South Side, Ring Road, Alloa</u>

If the recipient of this document is not the owner of the premises concerned, this document must be forwarded to the owner without delay.

It was brought to the attention of the Building Standards Team that the canopy at the above filling station had been damaged by vehicle impact. This impact resulted in several sections of the roof, fascia and soffit cladding being distorted and loosened resulting in a danger to the general public. Safety fencing was immediately erected on 9th December cordoning off the portion of the public highway in order to remove the immediate danger posed to the general public.

The safety fencing shall remain in place until permanent repairs have been effected on the canopy.

This letter should be treated as formal notification of operations executed under Sub Section 3 of Section 29 (Dangerous Buildings) of the above Act. On receipt of the final account for the operations noted above the costs shall be recharged to the appropriate owners.
