DANGEROUS WALL AT ALLOA ACADEMY, CLAREMONT, ALLOA**

On 2nd May, 2006 it was brought to the attention of the Building Standards Team that the wall indicated in red on the attached location plan was in a dangerous condition. A subsequent site visit, that day, confirmed that the wall was in an unstable condition and it appeared this could have been caused by recent impact damage. Due to the wall's condition and location, the Building Standards Team immediately instructed the Council's Property Services to demolish the wall and remove all debris from the site. This wall formed the only remaining part of the previously removed bicycle sheds.

**This letter should be treated as formal notification of operations executed under Sub Section 3 of Section 9 (Dangerous Buildings) of the above Act. On receipt of the final account for the operations noted above, the costs shall be recharged to Services to People.**
