I refer to the emergency safety operations carried out on 2nd June, 2008 by Clackmannanshire Council at the above property and wish to comment as follows.

As a result of vandalism, a section of masonry wall was removed on the gable elevation and a timber entrance door damaged, allowing unauthorised access into the building. As some of the internal elements of the building posed a danger, the Council took the necessary action in the form of securing the entry point after consultation with your architect.

This letter should be treated as formal notification of operations executed under Sub Section 3 of Section 29 (Dangerous Buildings) of the above Act.

On receipt of the final account for the operations noted above, the costs shall be recharged to the appropriate owner.
