



From West

1. Take A907 East towards Alloa.
2. At first large Dumyat View roundabout, take second exit to Dumyat South roundabout.
3. At Dumyat South roundabout stay on A907, take the second exit.
4. Follow the road for 2 miles through Cambus and into Alloa.
5. At the next roundabout, take 1st exit, and follow the road uphill onto the 1-way system.
6. Follow one way system round to the right to the next roundabout. Take first exit which takes you past Alloa Town Hall to large roundabout.
7. Still on A907, take 2nd exit at Town Hall roundabout onto King Street. Continue straight over small roundabout with railway station on left hand side. Keep to right hand lane.
8. At large roundabout at Asda, take third exit, continue straight over mini roundabout onto Auld Brig Road past Tesco onto Greenside Street towards Alloa Tower.
9. Turn first left after Tesco. Kilncraigs is a large glass fronted former mill building and is adjacent to Alloa Tower on Greenside Street.

From East

1. Take A907 West towards Alloa, keeping straight on past Alloa Athletic's football ground which is situated on the right hand side towards the town centre.
2. At large roundabout at Asda, take 1st exit, continue straight over mini roundabout onto Auld Brig Road past Tesco onto Greenside Street towards Alloa Tower.
3. Turn first left after Tesco into Kilncraigs car park. Kilncraigs is a large glass fronted former mill building and is adjacent to Alloa Tower on Greenside Street.

From Railway Station (approx 10 minute walk)

1. From station, take pathway straight ahead to pedestrian crossing (Asda on left).
2. Use pedestrian crossing to cross King Street and climb steps/ramp towards town centre.
3. Take first left into shopping area.
4. Turn right to bus station at Shillinghill and walk towards town centre.
5. Cross over the road and turn left at 'The Junction' pub and walk round to the right past the 'Old Brewery' pub towards Lidl on East Vennel.
6. Turn left just before Lidl and walk down pathway to pedestrian crossing.
7. Kilncraigs is on the opposite side of pedestrian crossing on Greenside Street.
