If the recipient of this document is not the owner of the premises concerned, this document must be forwarded to the owner without delay.

I refer to the emergency safety operations recently carried out by Clackmannanshire Council Building Standards Team on 3rd January 2013 and wish to comment as follows.

It was brought to the attention of this Authority that glazing had been smashed in a window at the front elevation of the property and was in danger of falling on the public footpath below.

After an inspection, the Council's Building Standards Team established that the glazing was in fact loose and, therefore, instructed the boarding up of the first floor windows in the interest of public safety. As joint owner of the building you may have a common interest in the maintenance of the property.

This letter should be treated as formal notification of operations executed under Sub Section 3 of Section 29 (Dangerous Buildings) of the above Act.

The local authority will shortly be in receipt of the final account for the works involved in removing the public danger, these costs shall be equally recharged in the future to both registered owners.
