DANGEROUS BUILDING NOTICE

Building (Scotland) Act 2003

Notice under Section 29 and 30 requiring owner to reduce or remove the danger constituted by a building

A building warrant is not required but a completion certificate must be provided.

In addition, the Local Authority may carry out the work itself and claim from you as a debt any expenses reasonably incurred by it in doing so.
