## Summary

Local residential services managed by the Council currently provide a combination of long term care and respite beds. The unit costs of providing these beds is approximately 30% higher than the equivalent purchase from a comparable independent sector provider

To achieve the national outcomes for health and social care integration, there is a need to develop preventative and enabling delivery models that keep people out of hospital and care homes where possible ie re-ablement services, intermediate care etc

We need to design services to meet the ever growing population of older people - ensuring better health and social outcomes for future clients whilst striving for best value.

This proposal recommends a comprehensive review and redesign of the current residential/respite care model with a view to developing an intermediate care service of short stay assessment care beds.

## Impact

This project would mean significant changes to the current service provided at Menstrie House. Long term care would no longer be Menstrie House's main provision. We would be looking to meet the demand for alternative supports to keep people in their homes. This would include specific dementia related services and short term care.
