CLACKMANNANSHIRE COUNCIL EMPLOYEE SEGREGATION ANALYSIS JULY 2017

All employees not including Education.

The figures in the tables below have been produced for all staff except education. The gender split within the Council workforce is 66.7% female and 33.3% male. There around twice as many women employed by the Council but there are a higher number of males in higher graded posts (grades 7 and above) - 19.4% males and 17% females.

There are higher proportions of females across all quartile groups with the most significant differences between the lower quartile and upper middle quartile.

The average hourly rate for employees is $\pounds 12.46$, with the average hourly rate for males higher than females. The average difference in hourly pay is $\pounds 0.74p$. The median pay rate is $\pounds 10.58$ with male median pay $\pounds 11.95$ and female median pay $\pounds 10.58$. The percentage pay gap is 3%.

The employee segregation for both disability and minority racial groups are provided below.
