



## **Clackmannanshire Council Contaminated Land Strategy** **September 2017 Update**

The Environmental Protection Act 1990(EPA), Part IIA (as amended), imposes a statutory duty on all local authorities to write a strategy on how it would identify and deal with contaminated land within its area of control.

In January 2000 Clackmannanshire Council published its '*Contaminated Land Strategy*' which outlined how this Council intends to implement the statutory regime.

In September 2012 Clackmannanshire Council published a reviewed and updated '*Contaminated Land Strategy*' which took into account changes in the statutory regime and responsibilities since the publication of the original strategy.

The September 2017 '*Contaminated Land Strategy Update*' is to bring to the attention of all interested parties and stakeholders that Clackmannanshire Council will be deviating from the 2012 Contaminated Land Strategy.

Following a re-structure we are currently researching alternative delivery methods for Contaminated Land within Clackmannanshire. Once a suitable method has been adopted to deal with contaminated land issues a reviewed and updated strategy will be produced.
