

1. Section 69(1)(b) of The Licensing (Scotland) Act, 2005 requires that the Licensing Standards Officer for the area be notified of all Extended Hours Applications. Section 69(3) of the Act requires the licensing Standards Officer to submit a report setting out his comments on the application within 10 days of such a notification.

Having read the content of the application and having made such enquiry as necessary I would like to make the following comments.

2. The application seeks to extend the terminal hour from 11:00 pm on Saturday 3rd September, 2022 until midnight.
3. The purpose of the extension is to facilitate a special event to be catered for on the premises
4. The special event is a live band and party night event.
5. The proposed extension is reasonable in the circumstances.
