I refer to the above subject and have to report as follows :-

Section 69(1)(b) of The Licensing (Scotland) Act, 2005 requires that the Licensing Standards Officer for the area be notified of all Extended Hours Applications. Section 69(3) of the Act requires the licensing Standards Officer to submit a report setting out his comments on the application.

1. Having read the content of the application and having made such enquiry as necessary I would like to make the following comments:-
2. Section 68 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act, 2005 states :-
 - 1) The appropriate Licensing Board may—
 - (a) on the application of the holder of the premises licence in respect of any licensed premises, and
 - (b) if the Board consider it appropriate to do so in connection with—
 - (i) a special event or occasion to be catered for on the premises, or

- (ii) a special event of local or national significance,
3. extend the licensed hours in respect of the premises by such period as is specified in the application or such other period as the Board consider appropriate.
 4. This report relates to an application to extend the terminal hour on Sunday 4 May 2025, from 1am until 2am
 5. The extended hours are sought to facilitate a 20th anniversary celebration of the business on the premises.
 6. The Premises Manager or another Personal Licence Holder will be on the premises for the duration of the event.
 7. Based on the information contained with in the submitted application having taken into consideration the relevant part of the Clackmannanshire Council Statement of Licensing Policy, and by reference to the legislation detailed above the Board must decide whether or not grant the application.
 8. I have no further comment to make about this application
