RC(24)09 APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF A SKIN PIERCING AND TATTOOING LICENCE (E MILLER)

The Licensing Authority had received an application for the grant of a Skin Piercing and Tattooing Licence. Representation on the application had been received from Environmental Health.

The applicant was not in attendance, having previously declined the invitation.

The Committee were asked to consider all the information before them and having done so to determine whether to grant the licence; grant the licence subject to local conditions; or refuse the application.

In the absence of the Licensing Paralegal, the CLSO introduced the Item of business and the the Committee had the opportunity to ask questions of the CLSO. The Committee then heard representation from the EHO and had the opportunity to put questions to him.

At the request of the Committee, the Clerk provided advice to the Committee on potential reasons for refusal as set out in legislation.
