Regulatory Committee

The Regulatory Committee, subject to the Council's approved policies, has responsibility for:

- Determining applications for the grant or renewal of any licences to be issued under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, including the imposition of conditions on any licence granted.
- 2. Determining whether to suspend or alter any licence issued under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
- 3. Determining whether to recall a suspension made pursuant to the terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
- 4. Setting, approving and reviewing any policies in respect of the operation of the licensing regime under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
- 5. Discharging the Council's statutory licensing function in respect of all legislation that imposes the duty on the Council as the appropriate authority to determine applications or to grant regulatory consents in respect of any licensable activities prescribed by statute.
- 6. Holding hearings and determining HMO Licence applications in terms of Schedule 4 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2006.
- 7. Dealing with regulatory and enforcement issues arising from matters delegated to or delivered by Community and Regulatory Services related to Environmental Health, Licensing (other than alcohol licensing) and Trading Standards.
- 8. Taking decisions on suspending or altering a premises approval as provided for under the Marriage (Scotland) Act 2002.
- 9. Holding hearings for the purposes of paragraph 7 of Schedule1 of the Smoking Health and Social Care (Scotland) Act 2005 (the SHSCA 2005).
- 10. Hearing appeals against officers' decisions to refuse or remove a landlord's or agent's registration under part 8 of the Antisocial Behaviour etc (Scotland) Act 2004.

RC(24)19 MINUTES OF REGULATORY COMMITTEE - 4 JUNE 2024

The minutes of the meeting of the Regulatory Committee held on Tuesday 4 June 2024 were submitted for approval.

Decision

RC(24)20 APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A TAXI DRIVER LICENCE

The Licensing Authority had received an application for the renewal of a Taxi Driver Licence from Mr John Stien Gold McDonald. Representations on the application had been received from the Civic Licensing Standards Officer (CLSO) and Police Scotland. Police Scotland later updated their representation which was circulated to the Regulatory Committee. Correspondence was received and circulated from Mr McDonald advising he would be on holiday at the time of the Regulatory Committee which set out his response. A letter of support was also received from Heather Buchan, Buchan Town Cars which was circulated to the Committee.

Mr McDonald (Applicant) was not in attendance, having submitted a letter advising that he was on holiday at the time of the Regulatory Committee, asking the Committee if they would accept his written communication to allow him to be heard.

RC(24)21 APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A TAXI DRIVER LICENCE

The Licensing Authority had received an application for the renewal of a Taxi Driver Licence from Mr Mohamad Khaled Deiraki. A representation on the application had been received from the Civic Licensing Standards Officer (CLSO).

Attending

The Committee were asked to consider all the information before them and having done so to determine whether to grant the licence; grant the licence subject to local conditions; or refuse the application.

The Committee heard representation from the Civic Licensing Standards Officer (CLSO) and the applicant; and had the opportunity to put questions to both. The Committee also asked for points of clarification from Police Scotland.

Following questions, the Chair adjourned the meeting to consider the application (10.41am). The Committee resumed at 10.50 am with 6 members present.

Motion

Having considered all the information presented to it and having had the opportunity for questions that the Committee refuses to grant the renewal application for a Taxi Drivers Licence.

Moved by Councillor Kenneth Earle. Seconded by Councillor Wendy Hamilton.

Decision

Having considered all the information presented to it and having had the opportunity for questions, the Committee agreed unanimously to refuse to grant the renewal application for Taxi Drivers Licence.

The reasons given were that, based on the evidence, the applicant was not a fit and proper person to hold such a licence in Clackmannanshire.

NON-EXEMPT ITEMS OF BUSINESS

RC(24)21 REVIEW OF TAXI OPERATORS' LICENCE DURATION

The report, submitted by the Depute Clerk to the Regulatory Committee, sought approval of the introduction of a taxi and private hire car operators' licence with a 3-year duration in addition to the existing and currently available 1-year licence option.

At the meeting of the Taxi and Private Hire Car Operators Forum on 10 April 2024 the issue of the 3-year licences was raised by members of the Forum. The Forum unanimously agreed that they believed this option would be beneficial to the trade, it was agreed that appropriate action would be taken to allow for this change to be implemented.

Decision

The Regulatory Committee unanimously agreed:

- 1. To approve the introduction of a taxi and private hire care operators' licence with a 3-year duration in addition to the existing and currently available 1-year licence option;
- 2. To approve a fee of £540 in relation to this licence subject to Council approval; and
- 3. To note that the increased fee relates to 2.25 times the current 1-year fee and creates a saving of £180 over a 3-year period for each operator that takes up a 3-year licence.
